GOAL:

To provide supplies to Foster, Adoptive, and Kinship families providing care to children under the age of 18.



WHAT?

- The Hope Closets exist in partnership with local churches to provide free clothing, supplies, diapers, formula, and toys for children in care.
- Caregivers are able to "shop," experiencing community support as they gather necessary resources for children in their care.



WHY?

- Many children enter foster care suddenly. Many are given a garbage bag to pack a few belongings, but otherwise they enter care with very little.
- Caregivers receiving new placements have quite a few needs. Replacing an entire wardrobe, purchasing formula, diapers, or other supplies incurs a large expense and items are needed immediately. As they grow and their developmental needs shift, the Hope Closet provides continuous support during their time in foster care.
